The Annual PREA Report for calendar year 2012, reflects this facility in a compliant manner with all standards and expectation of the policies pertaining to PREA. This report reflects a facility that houses a population of 235 inmates on average, with the mission of utilizing prison labor to successfully conduct and complete daily work production for the County. Dailey projects are grouped functionally by the directives of the Board of Commissioners, Warden, Deputy Warden, and Departments within the community. All Staff and departments, approved to work with Inmates of The Department of Corrections, have been properly trained and instructed on Standards of PREA.

During the 2012 PREA Year, we are pleased to note that there were no incidents. The review/inspection of the layout of the facility proved to be safe, with no improprieties or endangerments. Each Inmate was documented with receiving the proper training on what PREA represents and on how to incorporate the standards into their protection and safety.
